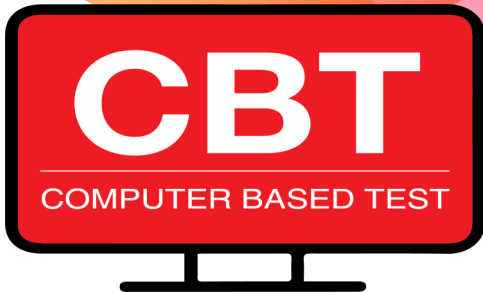

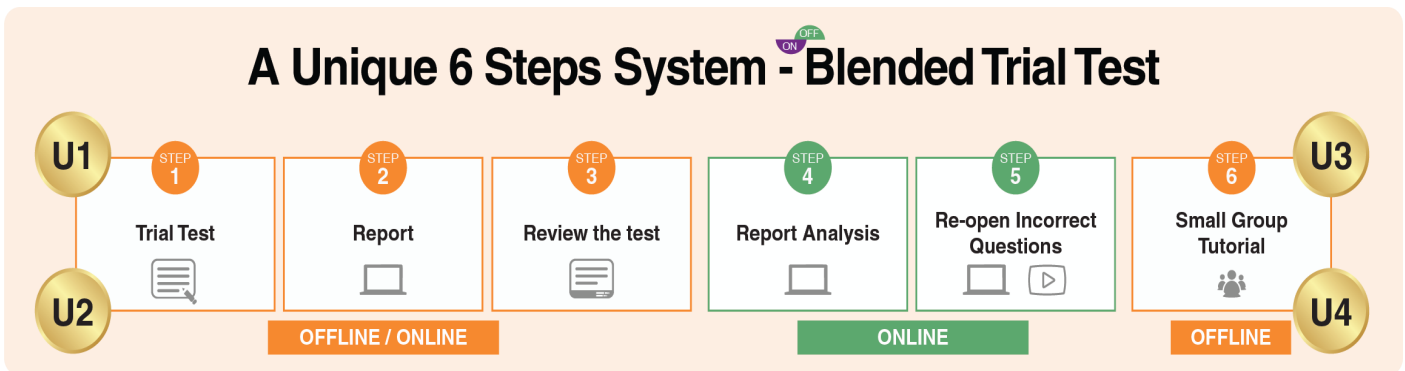

Selective Trial Tests (STT) Course

will start on 26th April 2025.

Students are introduced to specific category of questions to familiarise them to tests content. Teachers explain the various question types, techniques for answering questions and provide examples of questions at different levels of difficulty. Then they sit for a short test on those particular question types. After the tests, all questions are reviewed in class. Tests reports and online review of incorrect questions is available immediately to help students learn from mistakes made.

Step 1

Trial Test



1. Implemented to help familiarise students with up-to-date content, and learning environments

Introduction

Our Selective Trial Tests Course has been reviewed & restructured to include the Selective Preliminary Course to ensure that they are relevant, suitable & of high quality so that our students are best prepared for the 2026 Selective Schools Test. This course is a significant part of our program for Year 5 students who are enrolled in the Selective High School and Private School Scholarship Tests Preparation Course. For students attempting the 2026 Selective Schools Test, we have organised 10 Trial Test.

Unique System

To complement our Selective Trial Tests Course from Term 2, we have started the Selective Preliminary Course of 10 tests to familiarise students with different categories of questions, techniques of answering such questions, testing & evaluation and to help them apply knowledge in assessment.

At CS Education we have a unique Blended Learning system with the Trial Tests as support to the **Computer Based Trial Tests**. **For students enrolled in the Trial Tests Course both parents & children can REVIEW all incorrect trial test questions online for 1 week with video explanation after taking the test.** This is most beneficial as parents can help children at home and monitor their progress online as well.

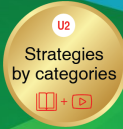




